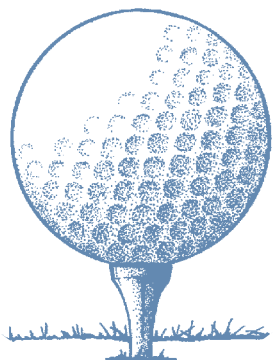


### DELAWARE VALLEY SCIENCE FAIRS AWARDEES

## PDE Scholarship Applications

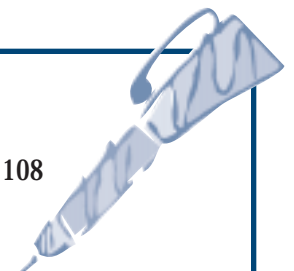
